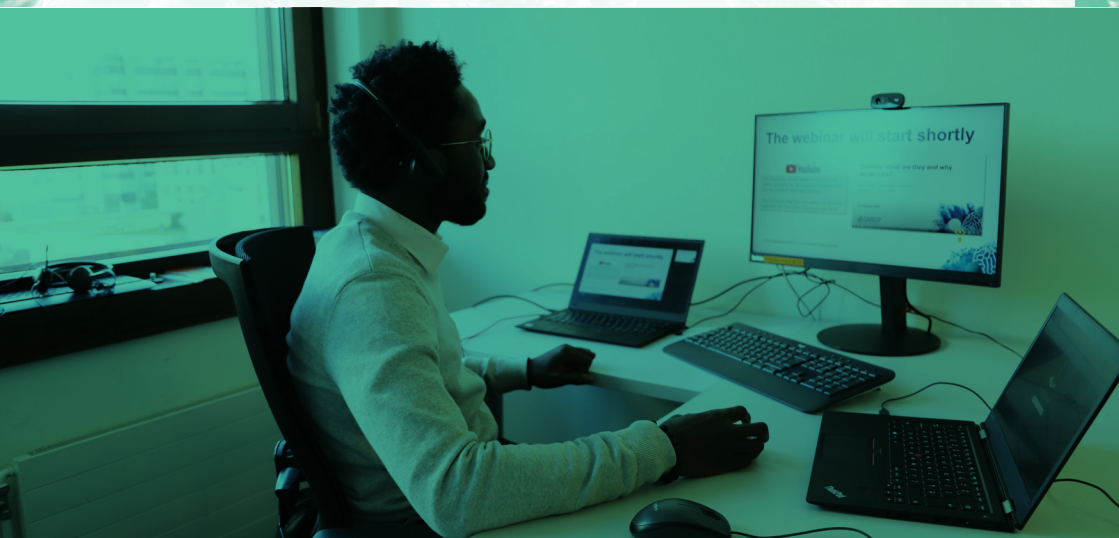
As companies continue to leave the field of antimicrobial R&D, many researchers have retired or re-focused their activities on other areas.
